**How to play Step-Skipping Along**

Cut out cards on the dotted line. Print out the game board to use with these cards. *Young children do better if they only learn one version of this game!*

**Beginning Version for 2 Players**

After passing out a game board for each player, designate one player to be "steps" and the other "skips". Use only the step and skip cards.

Place the cards face down. Each player takes a turn drawing a card. If it is a "step" the student who is designated "steps" will move to the next "note" on the game board. If it is a "skip", the other student moves to the next "note". The first to reach the end is the winner. (Students do not skip notes on the game board in this version.)

**Short Version**

As in the version above, use only the step and skip cards. Students take turn drawing cards, moving by steps or skips on the board. The first student who reaches the end is the winner.

**Long Version**

Use all the cards. If they draw a "Repeat" card, they will not move.

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
